APPROVED FLIGHT TRAINING ORGANISATION

1. This AIC is issued in the exercise of the powers conferred under Section 24O of the Civil Aviation Act 1969. Pursuance to Regulation 45 of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1996 and ICAO Annex 1, with effect from 1st August 2005, this AIC sets forth the requirements for the approval of a Flight Training Organisation. The document regulating this requirement is the DCA-FOdoc-03, the Approved Flight Training Organisation (AFTO) Manual.
2. An AFTO is an organisation staffed, equipped, and operated in a suitable environment offering flight training, and/or synthetic flight instruction and if applicable, theoretical knowledge instruction for specific flight training programmes approved by DCA Malaysia. DCA-FOdoc-03 outlines the procedures and requisites for the approval of an AFTO for a course of training for the Commercial Pilot's Licence and Instrument Rating. It supersedes the manual 'Approval of Flying Training Organisation' third revision dated April 2004. Factors that set the necessity for its complete review are the imposition of a Quality Assurance System, requirement of flight safety documents system and document control procedures.
3. Organisations that have been granted and organisations seeking such approval are to meet the requirements prescribed in DCA-FOdoc-03.(AFTO Manual.)
